


Global Softwood Lumber Production


Global Forest Products Trade






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Global Trade of Wood Raw-Material






Wood Chip Trade in Europe


Global Sawlog Price Index (GSPI) 1Q/95 – 3Q/18





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
Log Prices for Key Lumber Producers 3Q/18


Global Wood Fiber Price Indices 1Q/88 – 3Q/18



- Higher Prices of Wood Raw-Material in 2018




Softwood Log Imports to Finland and Sweden






Log Exports as Share of Timber Harvest


Lumber Exports from Finland and Sweden





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Relative Sawlogs Prices in the Nordic Countries






Wood Markets – North America

- Canada is Still the Largest Lumber Exporter in the World




US Lumber Consumption, Production and Trade

Softwood Lumber Production in the US




Overseas Lumber Imports to the US

Residual Chip Prices in North America






Wood Markets - China

- High Log and Wood Fiber Costs




Imports of Softwood Logs and Lumber to China

Softwood Lumber Imports to China




Lumber Prices, Wood Costs and Gross Margins

Key Takeaways

- The global forest industry has been in a steady expansions mode for almost ten years.
- China and the US have continued to be major importers of softwood lumber in 2018 even if shipments slowed slightly towards the end of the year.
- Global wood raw-material costs increased during 2017 and 2018 reaching their highest levels in three years in 2018.
- Outlook for global lumber demand is likely to be lower in 2019 with possible improvements in 2020/21.
